## **ACTION 5**

Descriptive feedback includes concise, strength-based, written comments or documented conversations that are aligned with the learning standards and describe student learning, as well as identifying specific areas for future growth. A strength-based approach recognizes that student learning is dynamic and holistic, and that students demonstrate their learning in different ways and at different rates.

Descriptive feedback about what a student knows, can do and what they are working toward and should note significant events in the student's growth, development, and learning.
